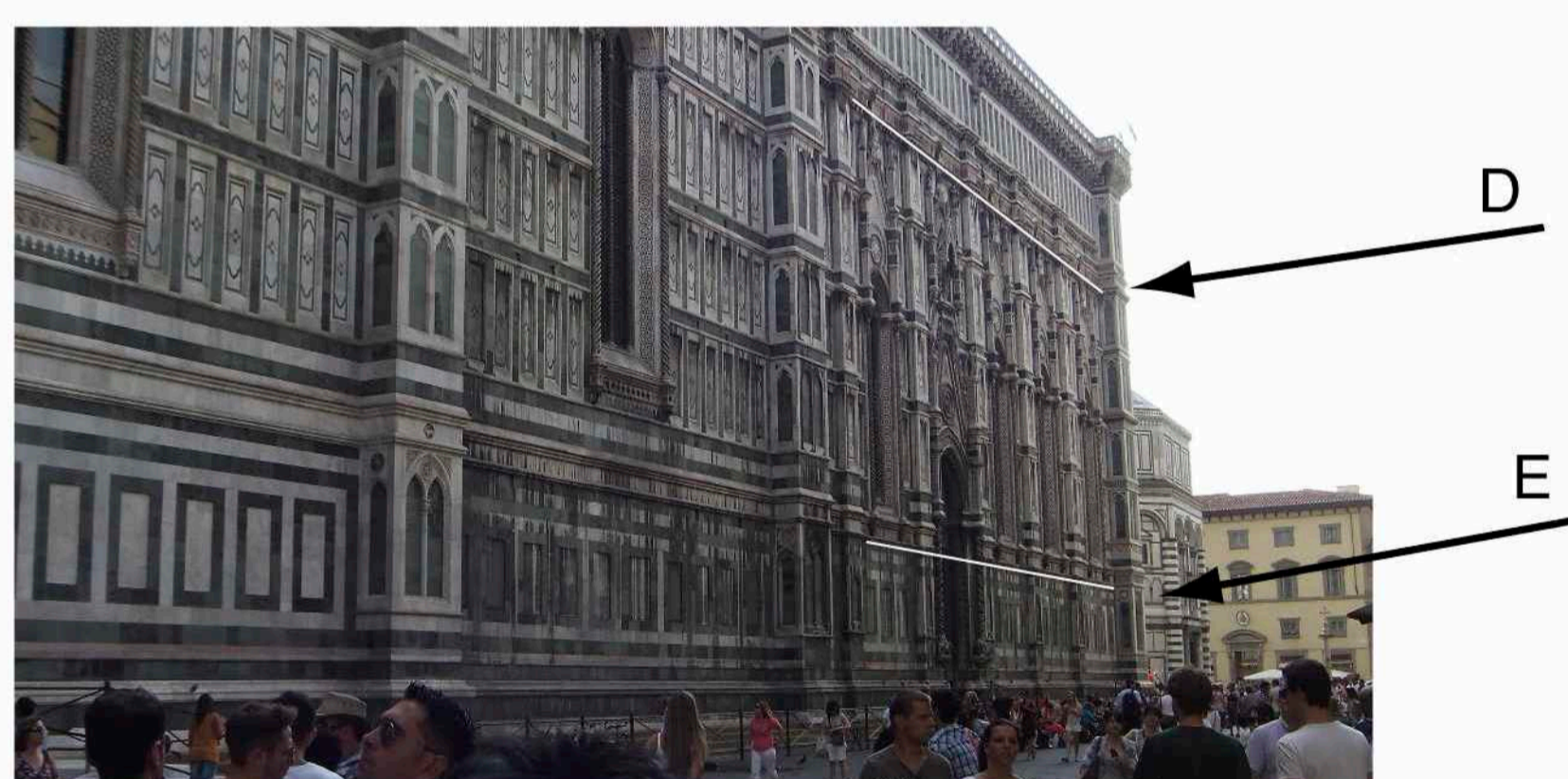
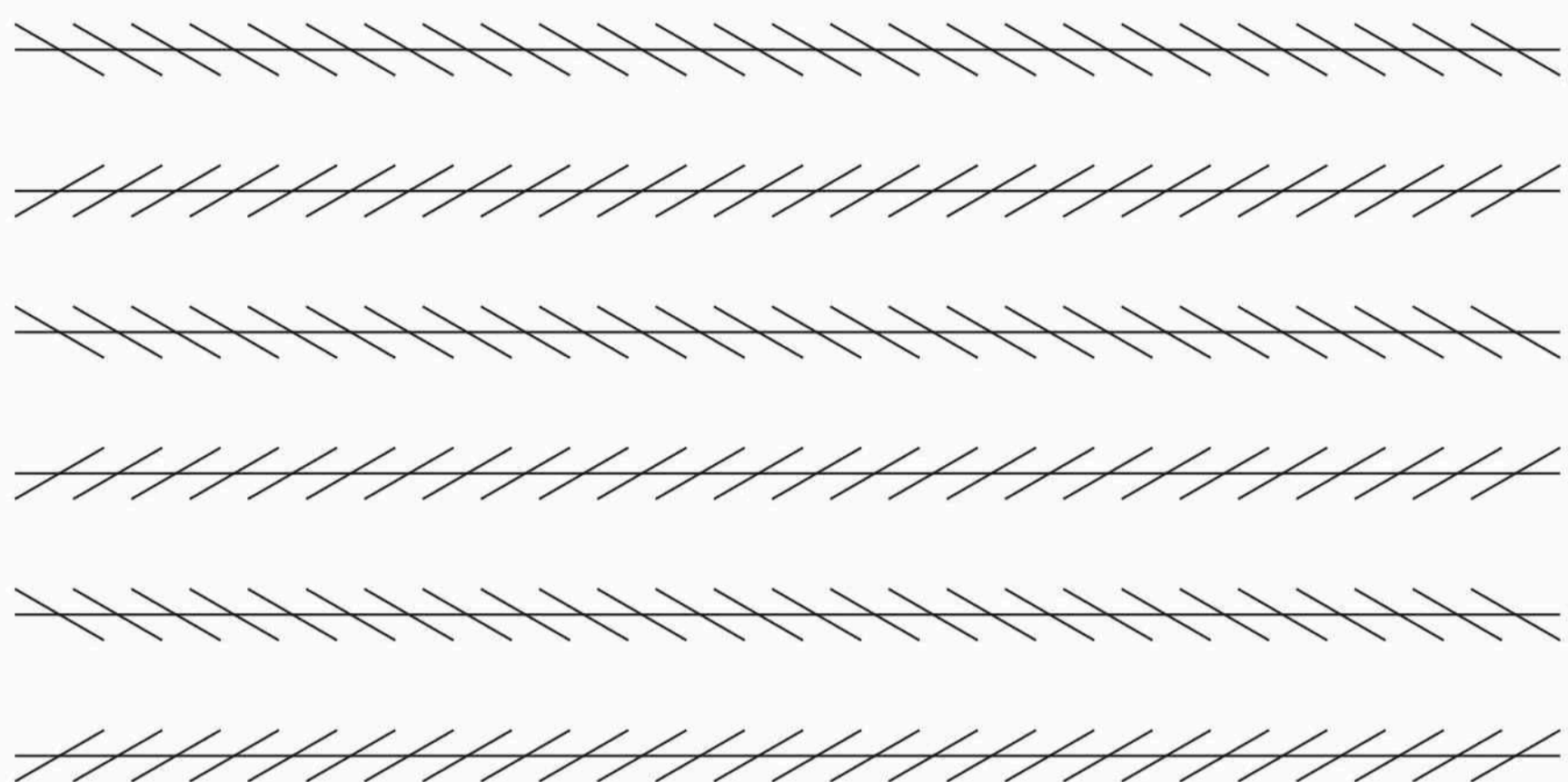


Angle illusion in viewing pictures with linear perspective

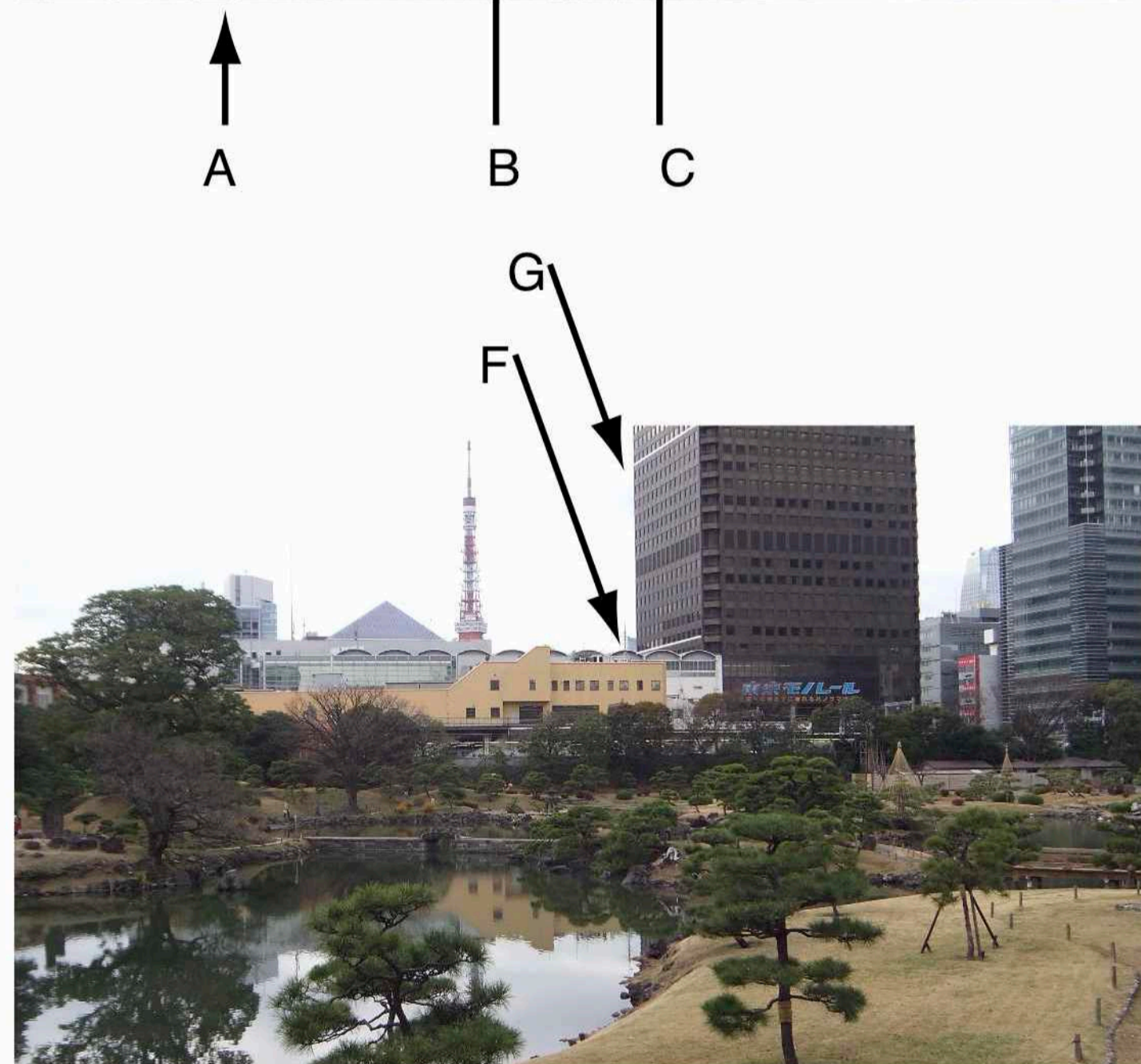
Angle illusion

- Amount of angle illusion, such as Zölner illusion, is usually less than 10 degree.



Angles in pictures with linear perspective

- Angles in pictures with linear perspective is illusorily underestimated.



- A-B: 46 deg
- A-C: 55 deg
- D-E: 27 deg
- F-G: 19 deg
- H-I: 20 deg
- J-K: 113 deg
- L-M: 98 deg
